June 2011 Contest Report

Not a bad roll up for the 6.30am gathering in the car park. The morning was cool and clear with an off-shore breeze, and the swell had calmed down from the previous days, with the tide rising to high about 10.30am and the swell pumping.

The decision was made to hold the contest on the break north of Wanda Surf Club. We had 37 members who elected to pick a card (in lieu of the box) to surf, and we ended up with six heats going forward, with the first heat in the water about 7.30am. The early heats experienced the larger sets closing out, however it did get better with the incoming tide.

Members should note that we are now allocating a "Head Judge" for each heat and that this is signified by an "H" next to the member's name. To assist everyone, please ensure you check to see if you are allocated the Head Judge position on the list appropriate to the heat you are surfing in. Members judge the heat two heats prior to the heat they surf in, or in the case of the first heat, the third heat.

The Committee has also decided after some trial and error to now run the first place-getters heat as the initial heat of the second round in every comp. This will be followed by the second place-getters heat etc. This decision was taken to ensure we effectively hold the bank during the round transition and it also allows the folding together of some of the lower place-getters heats if members drop out.

As "Joe the Gadget Man" used to say, "don't forget to support the Classic and the club raffle and bring your money with you"! It is all for a good cause and you have the chance to get some great gear thanks our sponsors.
