### **Presidents Reports**

A following meeting was held with Greg Willet, Andy Taylor attended and Greg outlined his proposal and generous offer to once again sponsor the spring classic to the tune of \$5,000. Arrangements are currently in place to have Greg's staff help in the design and selection of the spring classic comp shirt.

## **Contest Directors Report**

The feedback has been good for the grommet heat which will continue subject to conditions and having enough grommets.

The issue of grading was reviewed and this will be available for the June round now we have nearly all the memberships in. This is one of the problems with late memberships which can affect those in what grade if done too early.

The usual issue of head judges for each heat arose. The committee decide that the two contest directors Ross or Roy will nominate from the heat judges a Head Judge who will also be the spotter. The choice will be someone with experience who can help guide and coach new members whilst ensuring consistency across the heat eg all waves recorded etc (which is a problem)

In the February Round assistance from members in distributing the judging folders was great but this has slipped and the committee resolved to approach a few members to automatically handle this task each comp.

## **Gear Steward**

Peter reported that the new batteries went well and all the gear is in order. The pack up has been very good this year with the extra members staying back , thanks to everyone.
